

HOW TO MAKE AN INEXPENSIVE GARDEN

Seed-spacing Template

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Remove the pegboard from the package and place it front-face up on a flat surface.
- 2. Using the markers, pick one color and make the main central mark on the board.
- 3. To mark the 2-inch holes, choose another color to mark every 2 holes, starting from the central mark and counting outward.
- 4. To mark the 3-inch holes, choose a third color to mark every 3 holes, starting from the central mark and counting outward.
- 5. To mark the 4-inch holes, choose a forth color to mark every forth hole, starting from the central mark and counting outward. This mark will overlap the 2-inch marks, so outline around the original color where the 4-inch marks go.
- 6. Since the board isn't quite big enough to include every 6 holes vertically or horizonally, mark the corners which are nearly 6 inches from the center to the corner.
- 7. If you would like to label the marks, you can do that with a pencil or marker.

♥ INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

- 1. Place the template in the garden space where you are sowing seeds.
- 2. Look on the seed package to verify the seed spacing and depth of planting.
- 3. Mark the matching holes for the measurement you verified, poking all the way through to make a hole that matches the depth for planting.
- 4. Once the holes are made, drop in 1-2 seeds.
- 5. Remove the template and cover with soil. Water them in gently.
